When jigging in high current or deep areas, try the Fin-Tech Nucleball "Zone-R". It's streamlined head reduces drag in the water and allows your presentation to get to the bottom easier. You'll maintain better feel, which in turn, will put more fish in the boat!

Rigging with slip sinkers is one of the most popular techniques for catching walleyes on many different bodies of water. The "EZ Change" Tech Stik was designed to incorporate the best of all worlds in a slip sinker. There are several color options, a rattle chamber, and best of all, interchangeable weights. This slip sinker allows you to fish at a variety of depths without continuously retying your setup. Just unplug a weight and put a different color/size in, it's really that easy!!

When fishing in dirty water, whether in a river system or a lake, try the Nucleball "Day-Brite" color lineup. The metallic finishes of these jigs give fish something to key in on, to get you more bites!

Fin-Tech Nucleball jigs are fantastic all around jigs for pitching, vertical, or dragging applications. The stand-up head design will keep your presentation up off the bottom making it easier for fish to "suck" the jig in. With the hook being off the bottom, you will also experience less snags. Along with the use of live bait or artificial tails, these jigs are a great weapon to catching a variety of species of fish!
