

Title SHot Jig

With all Title SHot jigs , buy all the colors of skirt pads you could ever want (do-itcorp.com) to "pre make" skirts to use with your jigs to change at a moment's notice to change with conditions , and make extras of your favorite colors to have on hand to rig in the boat. Also use the collars that you can attach rattles, or take them off when you want. Cut the skirt short and use any variety of scented plastics to make this one of the most versatile and deadly jigs in your boat! It's a different profile and action from conventional bass jigs. And to keep up with the "swimjig" craze, use the 3/16 size in white with white combinations to mimic shad, and black with blue/brown combinations (your limitless with colors if you make your own skirts) to mimic bluegill. Try to match the predominant forage in the body of water you are on. This jig will swim through slop and wood like NO other. Use Kalin 3" and 4" single tails in colors that also resemble the desired forage. This presentation will also give a different profile for pressured bass from "traditional" swim jigs on the market. "Texpose" the hook for unbeatable hooking percentages.
